

# Introduction

The educational and training materials generated by the InTSEnSE project comprise two modules:-

- Module 1: An Introduction to the Internationalisation of Social Enterprise
- Module 2: Leading, Managing and Sustaining an International Social Enterprise

The core written material in the modules reflects the real life experiences of the social enterprise actors interviewed from the case study organisations that contributed to the InTSEnSE project.
